

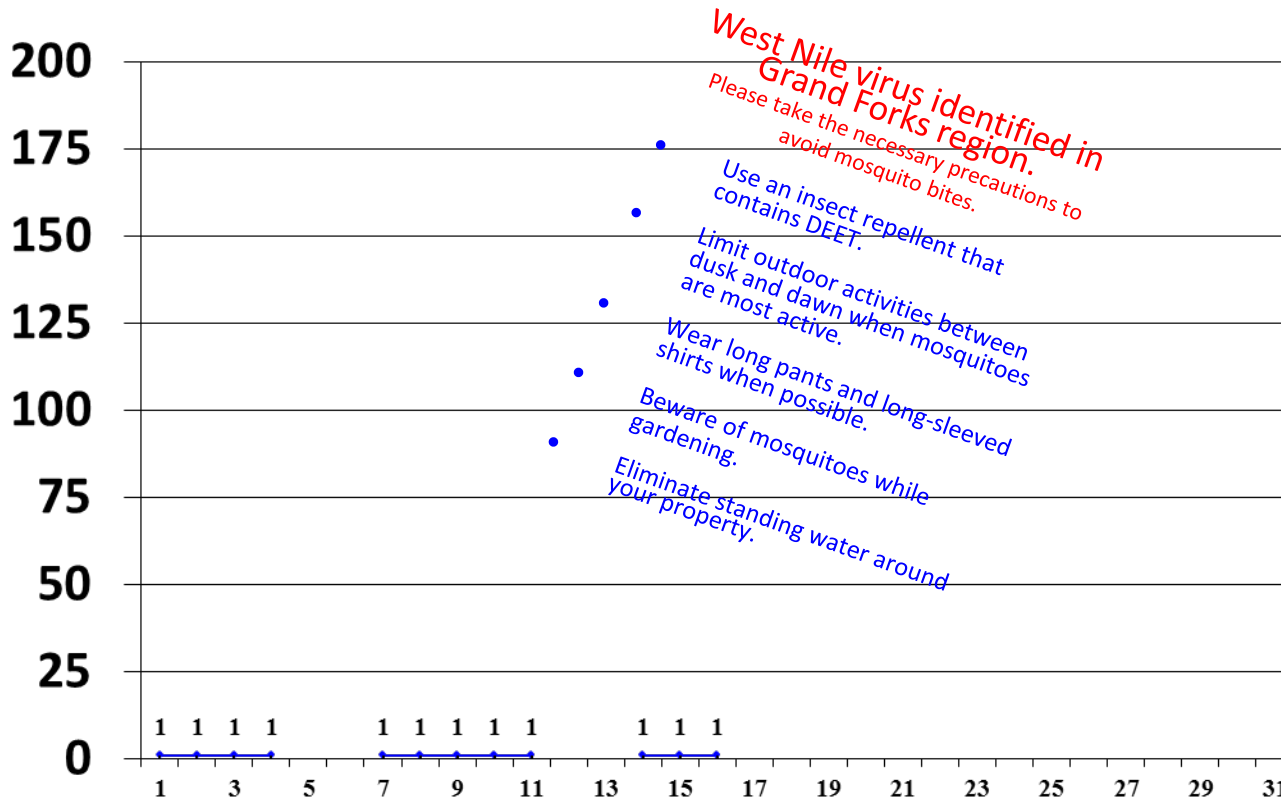

- Citywide Ground Spraying

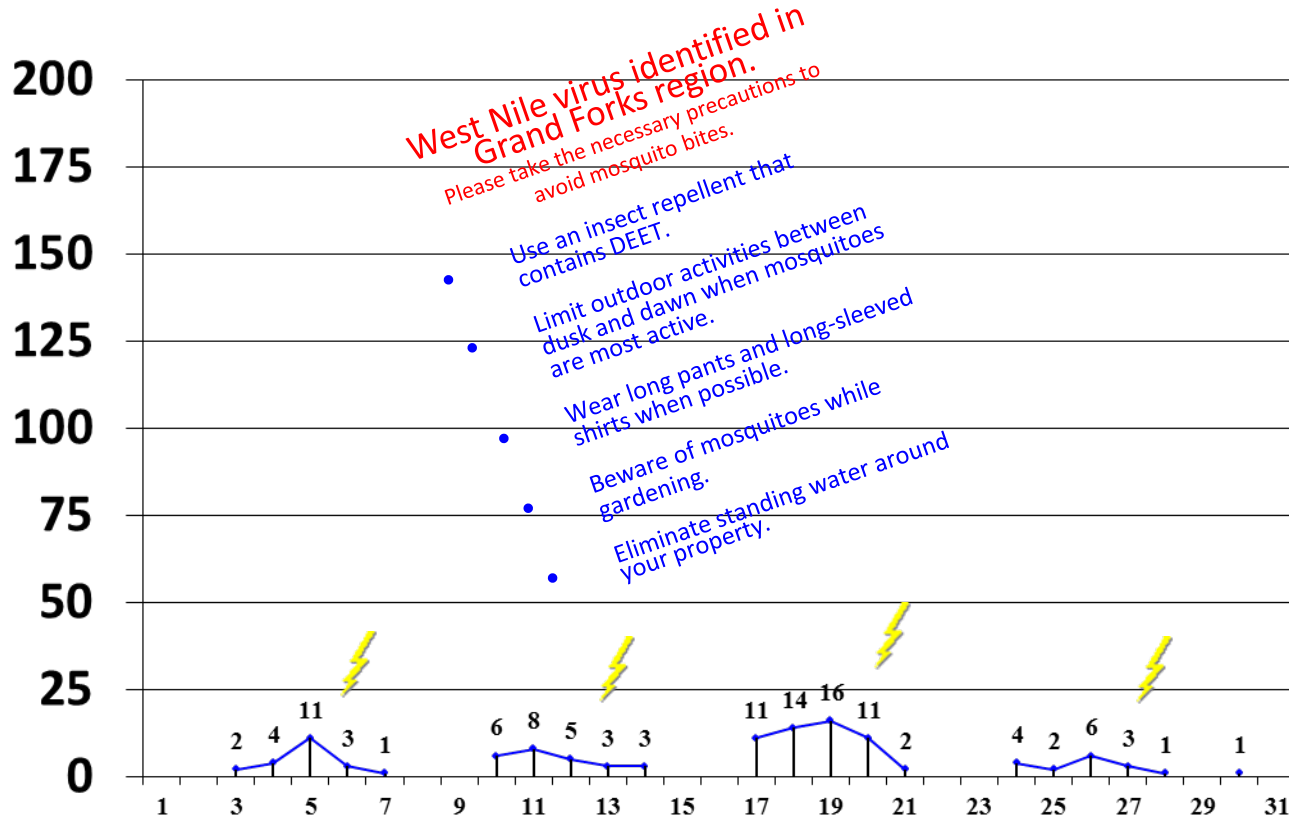

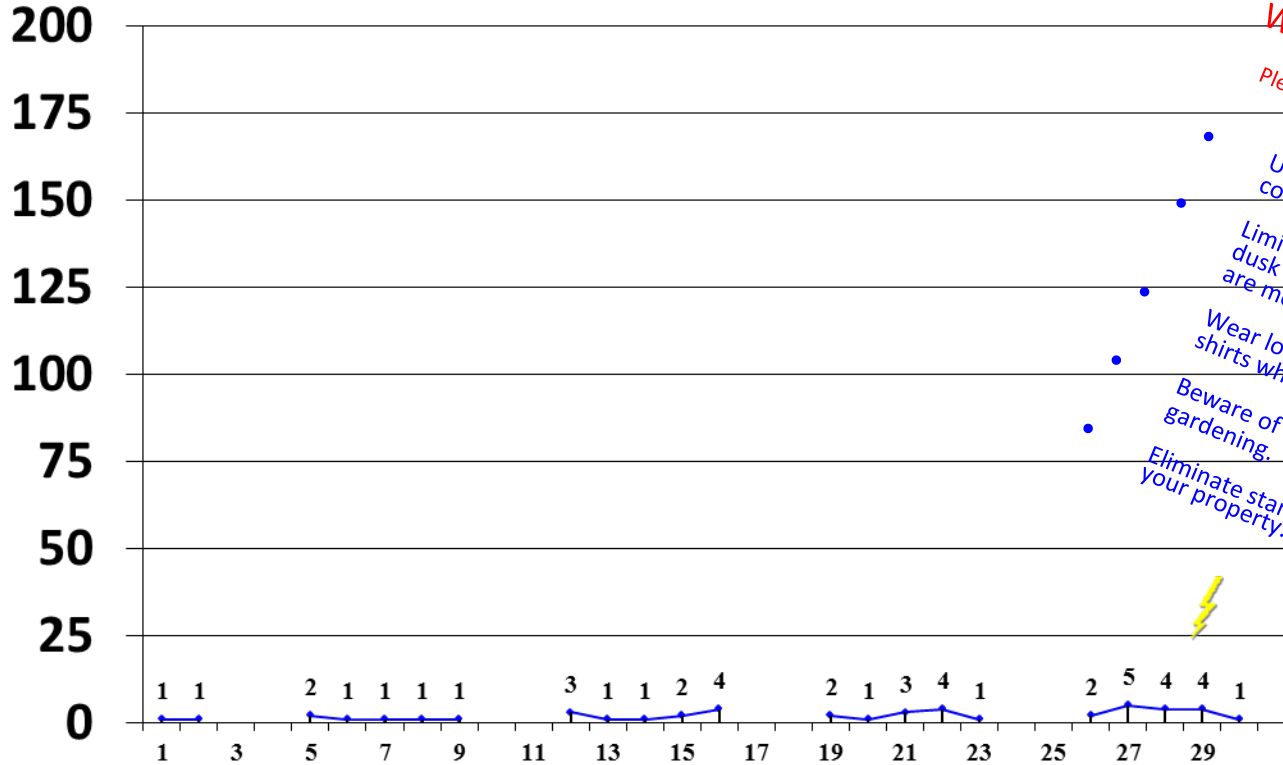

West Nile virus identified in Grand Forks region.
Please take the necessary precautions to avoid mosquito bites.

- Use an insect repellent that contains DEET.
- Limit outdoor activities between dusk and dawn when mosquitoes are most active.
- Wear long pants and long-sleeved shirts when possible.
- Beware of mosquitoes while gardening.
- Eliminate standing water around your property.
