

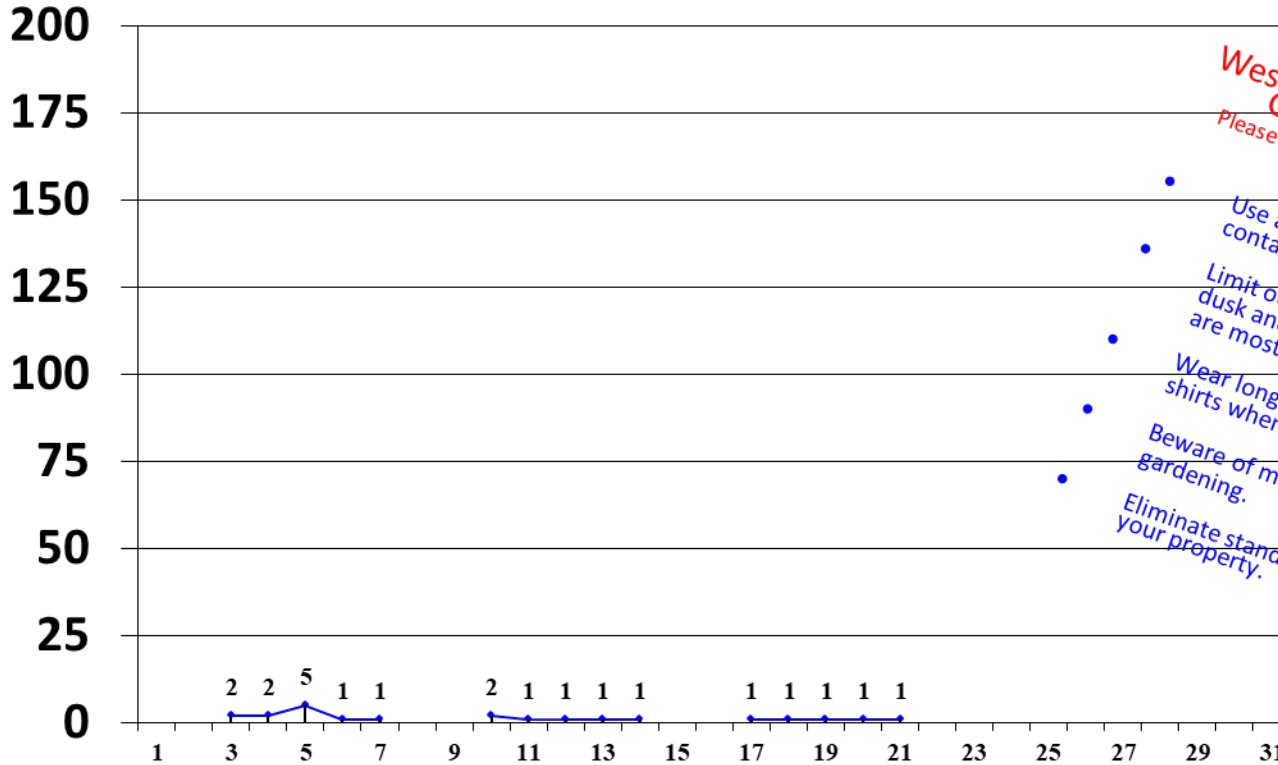

## Average Daily Trap Count – September 2018



**West Nile virus identified in Grand Forks region.**  
Please take the necessary precautions to avoid mosquito bites.

Use an insect repellent that contains DEET.

Limit outdoor activities between dusk and dawn when mosquitoes are most active.

Wear long pants and long-sleeved shirts when possible.

Beware of mosquitoes while gardening.

Eliminate standing water around your property.

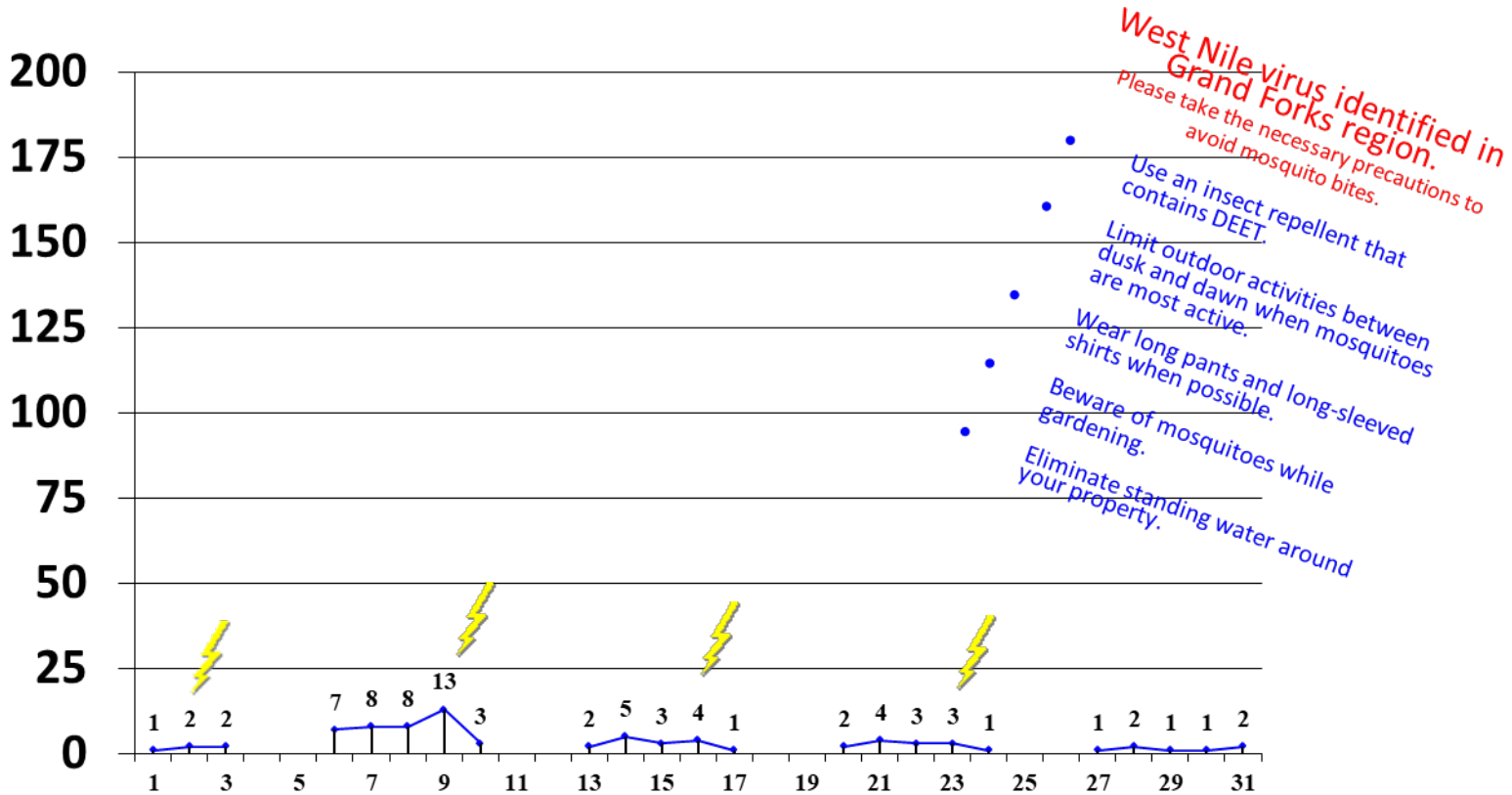

 - Citywide Ground Spraying

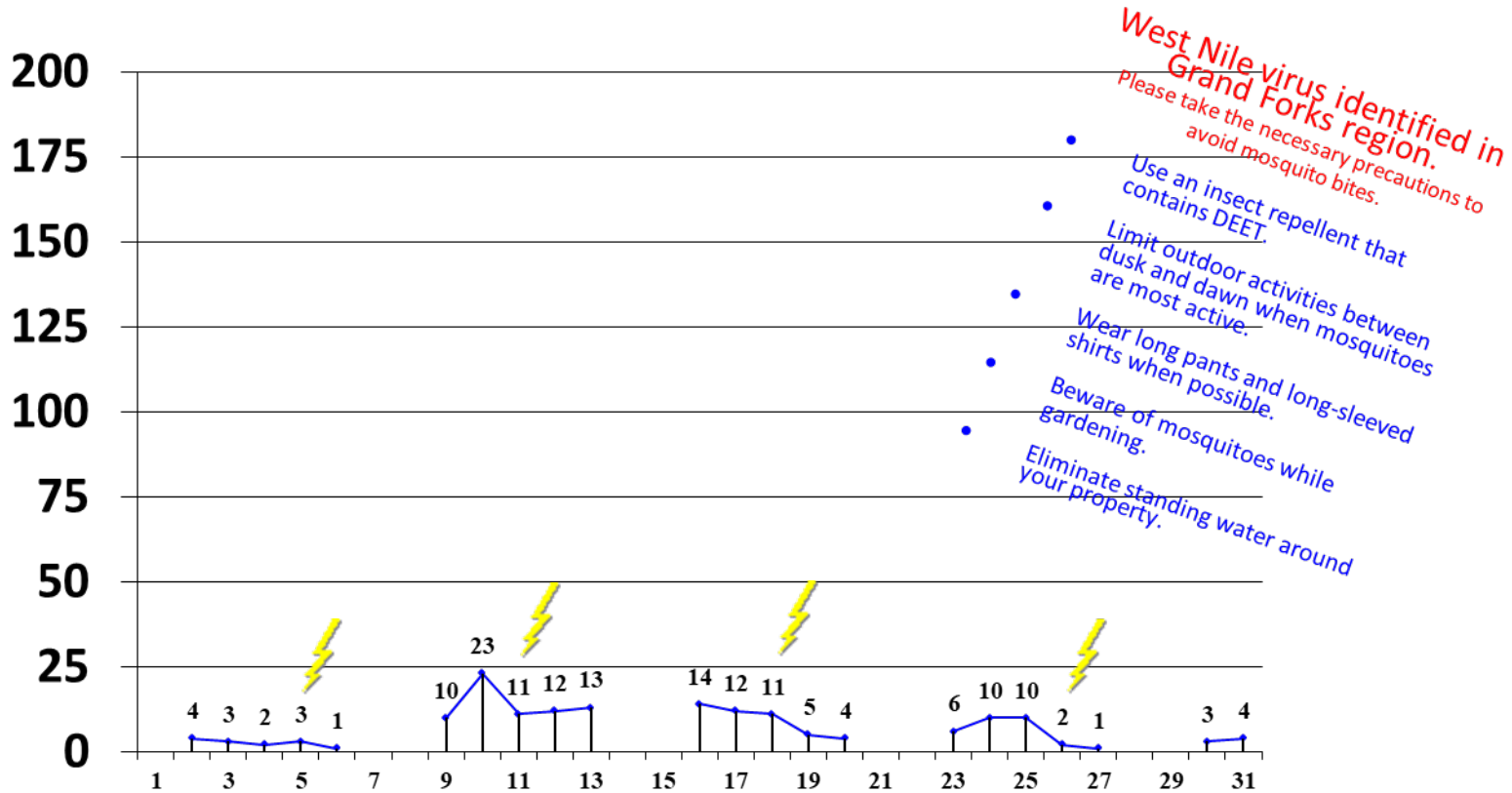

 - Citywide Ground Spraying

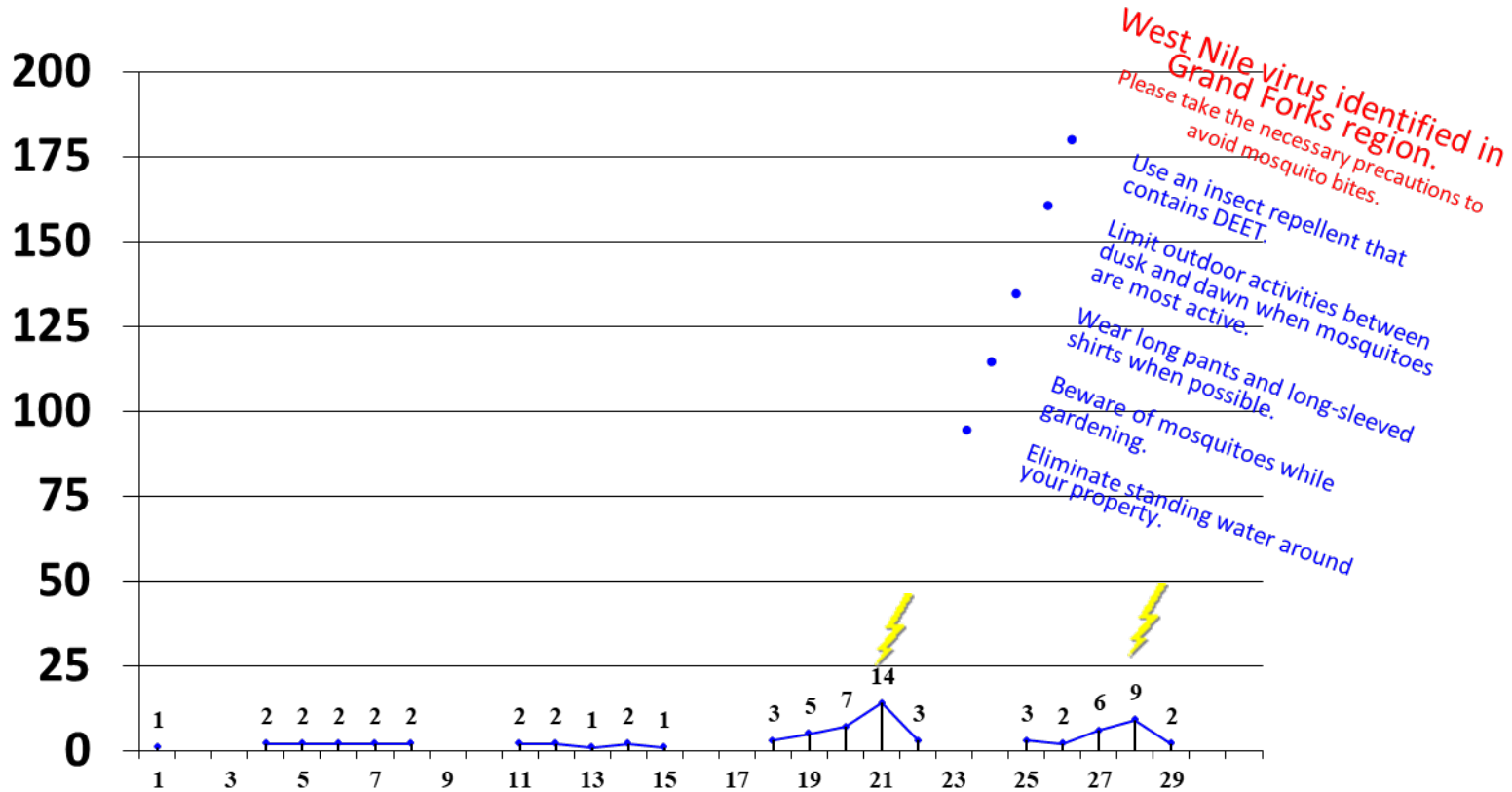
